Primary Care Quality Improvement Programs

Blue Cross VT operates two primary care quality improvement programs that pay incentives to providers, add benefits for our members and track quality metrics to evaluate key successes and opportunities for our state's health care system.

available to providers who meet or exceed quality measure thresholds. *Average practice payment is \$2.78 PMPM.*

- Launched in 2024, building on VBIC successes
- Scorecards showing individual practice performance against the threshold and peer benchmarks are sent to practices annually
- Quality measures include percentages of patients receiving breast and colorectal cancer screenings, immunizations, and annual wellness exams
- No additional provider administration or reporting is required to participate in the program, as Blue Cross VT uses existing data

- Launched in 2022
- Quality measures focus on patients' annual wellness exams, colorectal cancer screenings, and controlling diabetes and blood pressure
- Utilization measures include use of in-house or independent labs, avoidable ER use, and lower cost MRI/CT imaging facilities
